Application for New Zealand Virtual Micro-Internship Programme

You are invited to apply for an **exciting opportunity offered by Education New Zealand (ENZ) and the University of Auckland (UoA)**. The application form will be closed at 11:59pm, Sunday, 21 May 2023 (Viet Nam time).

The 3-week Virtual Micro-Internship Programme is an opportunity to work with New Zealand and multinational organisations on real world problems, together with students from different countries (Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, Korea, Japan, and India) based on your study background and time zone.

You will be supported by interactive learning content and dedicated mentors. This programme is held online so you can join from wherever you are!

What is a virtual micro-internship?

A virtual micro-internship is a 3-week programme with around 10-15 hours of work per week, designed to accelerate your professional growth.

You'll be working in a team of 4-6 students to tackle a business challenge for an Auckland-based employer. Each team will be provided with a dedicated mentor, to coach and support you throughout the programme.

The programme includes an online induction and briefing session to get to know your team and the project you will be working on together.

Everything can be accessed virtually through the online platform provided by UoA where you can connect with your team, access and submit documents, as well as receive feedback from your mentor. At the end, you will get the opportunity to present your findings.

During this virtual micro-internship, you will:

- Understand what it's like to work in the New Zealand business context
- Receive professional mentoring and training
- Build your professional profile and grow your network
- Gain relevant NZ work experience to add to your CV

Preparation

- English Certificate or any evidence of your English proficiency level, this will help you gain advantages in being selected for the programme.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) in English
- A link to your video (max 1.5 minutes) to introduce about yourself and the reason why you want to participate in this programme.
 - Please make sure to check if the sound is clear and video's quality is good (720p or above).
 - You can upload your video on Google Drive, Sharepoint or Youtube, etc. but remember to set the link open for all to view.
